**Shipping –**

As of 5/2011, USPS flat rate is \$11 for medium box, \$15 for large. Medium should be plenty big.

Otherwise, use whatever box is at hand. Always compare cost - Priority vs. flat rate.

Paying with Pay Pal? I will bill you once I get the package, with an invoice.

Is your packaging re-usable? If not, include the extra cost in your total.

Did you include return postage, before sealing the box?

Did you include return postage and costs, in your total cost?

Did you insure your box and include cost of insurance back to yourself?

Are the knives wrapped securely? Did you place a copy of your vital info in the box?

Flat rate priority, usually works best if your sending more than one or two/three knives.

USPS will provide you with a free box, and it is by far the fastest way to ship.

**UPS and Fed Ex**

There is a \$5 surcharge to use these services, unless you have an account, and ship or mail a return postage label with your box. That way UPS or Fed Ex will pick up the package and I can wave the surcharge.
